COURSE OVERVIEW AND OBJECTIVES

This course will introduce the student to the various aspects of church life and ministry including leadership, membership, finances, missions, etc. Each student will be encouraged to discover the place in Christ's church where He has uniquely gifted them to serve.

COURSE REQUIRMENTS

Class Attendance

Class attendance is required and will be checked at each session. A student who misses more that 25% of the class meetings will forfeit credit for the class and receive a failing grade, unless an arrangement is made with the professor to complete the work online. Reading Assignments (25% of Final Grade)

Notebook Assignment (25% of Final Grade)

Keep a notebook devoted specifically to this course. The notebook should contain all course handouts along with all of the notes and assignments that you do for this course. Organization of materials is important to make them accessible for future use.

Research Project (50% of Final Grade)

The research project will be assigned during the final class.

Each student will write an autobiography of their experience in church life and ministry.

This should include a history of:

- Churches joined and positions held.
- Important events and lessons learned.
- Discovery of individual giftedness.

The paper should conclude with a portion looking to the future answering the question "What do I believe God has called me to do in the church where I am currently serving?"

This research project will be submitted in the following format.

A title page which includes the course title, number, student name, and professor name.

The body of the project should be well-organized and be no less than three pages and no more than five pages (double spaced).

A properly cited bibliography page (Student may choose APA or MLA formatting).
